The CareLink uploader allows you to upload the information in your pump or meter to the CareLink website. Before you can begin to upload your data to CareLink[™] software, you will first need to download and install the CareLink[™] Uploader. Once installed, you will not need to repeat this process, unless you are uploading from a new computer.
